Corbin: I finally had a chance to read this ms. I think it might be worthwhile to comment on the effect of genotyping error on trios (family) based analysis using imputation. If there is error in the chip based imputation then this will lead to a different p value for the imputed vs the sequenced results due to genotyping error from the imputation. The degree of error will be based on how effectively the rare variants are imputed. I didn't see this concept discussed so might be worthwhile including.
